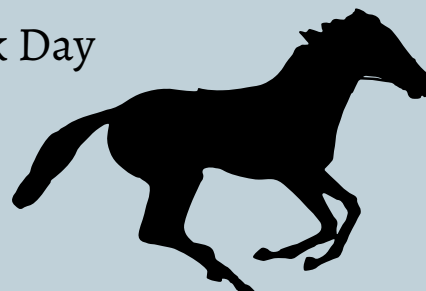

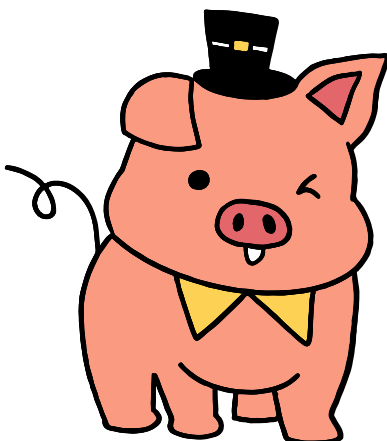
4-Hers in Wylie 4-H showed in the Wylie Livestock Show in March. A few highlights include:
