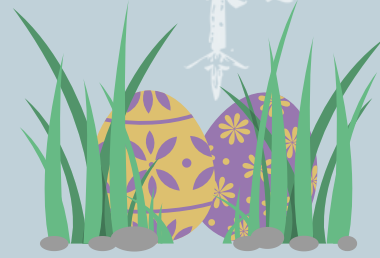

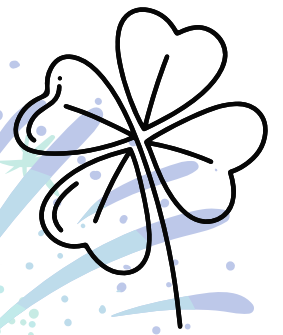

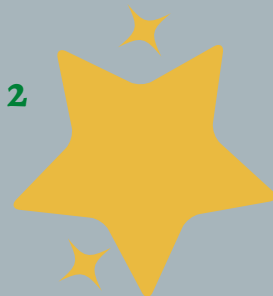

## All Saints Ag Day



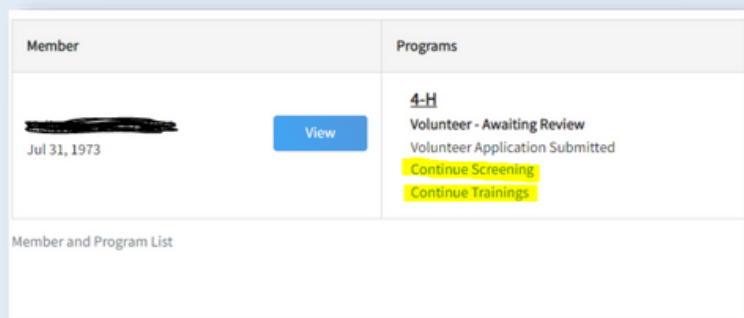

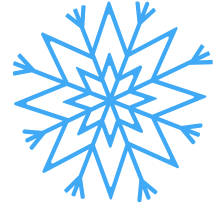
