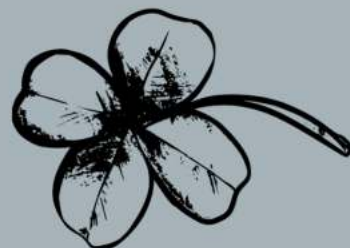

Youth who wish to apply for Clover Campaign money must participate at a TSC during **both** Clover Campaigns. Please speak with your club manager or Amanda if you have questions.

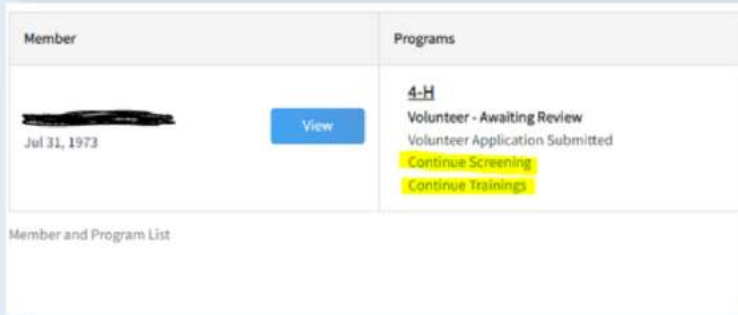

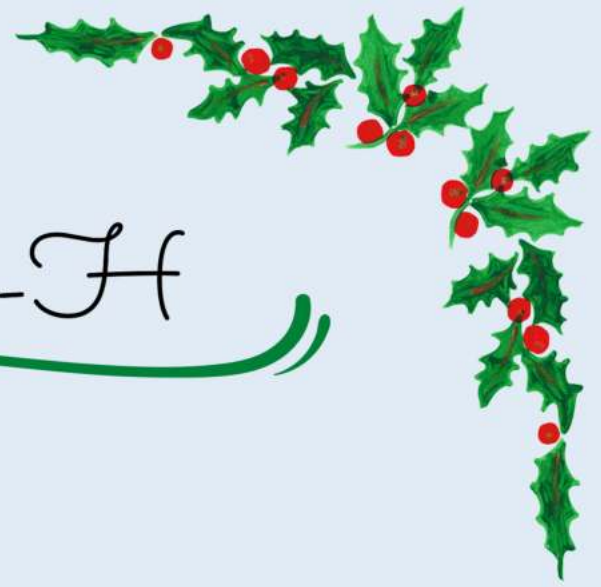


## Wylie Livestock Show
