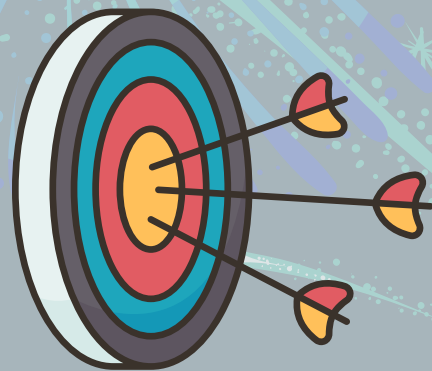

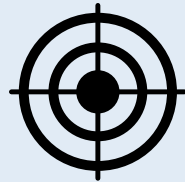
County president Anna Magnuson and County Secretary Olivia Callagher took baked goodies to our county judge and commissioners to thank them for their support of Collin County 4-H !!

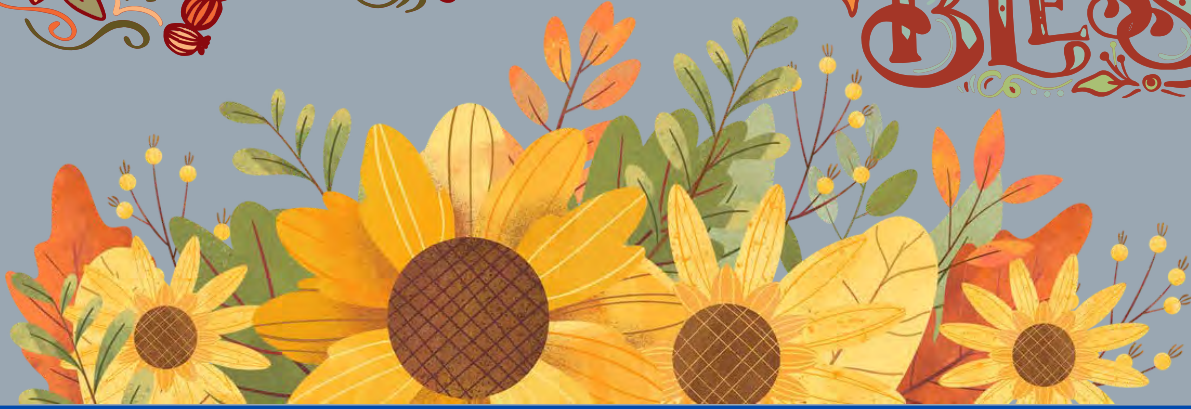
